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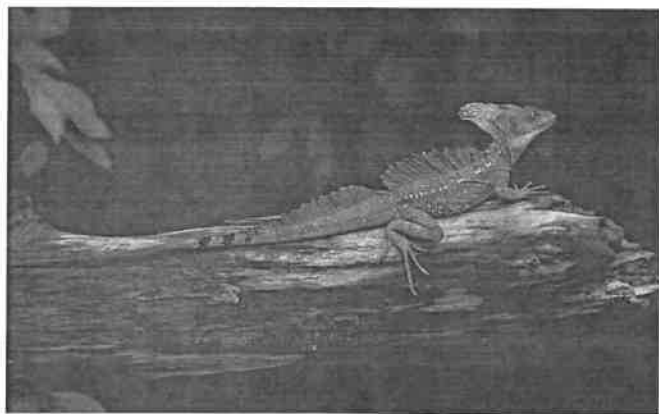
# Physical Adaptations

Animals depend on their physical features to help them find food, build homes, attract mates, and stay safe from predators.

These physical features are called **physical adaptations**. They make it possible for an animal to live in a particular place and in a particular way. When you think about physical adaptations remember it's about physical features or how an animal looks.

Animals have many physical adaptations including:

- Different kinds of feet
- Sharp beaks or teeth
- Long tongues
- Long legs or tails
- Sharp claws or fingers
- Thick or thin fur or skin
- Color, pattern, or shape



One of the most commonly known physical adaptations is **camouflage**. **Camouflage** is the color, patterns, shape, or texture that helps an animal blend in with its environment.
